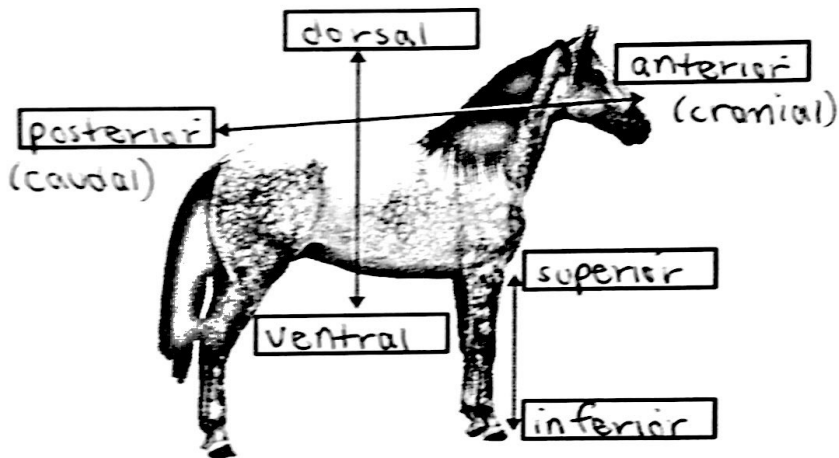
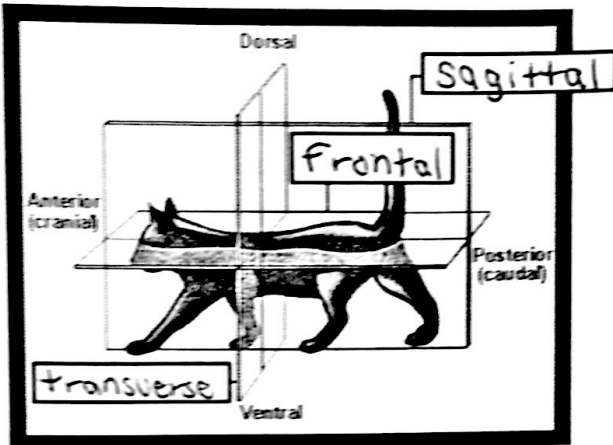


Fetal Pig Dissection Review

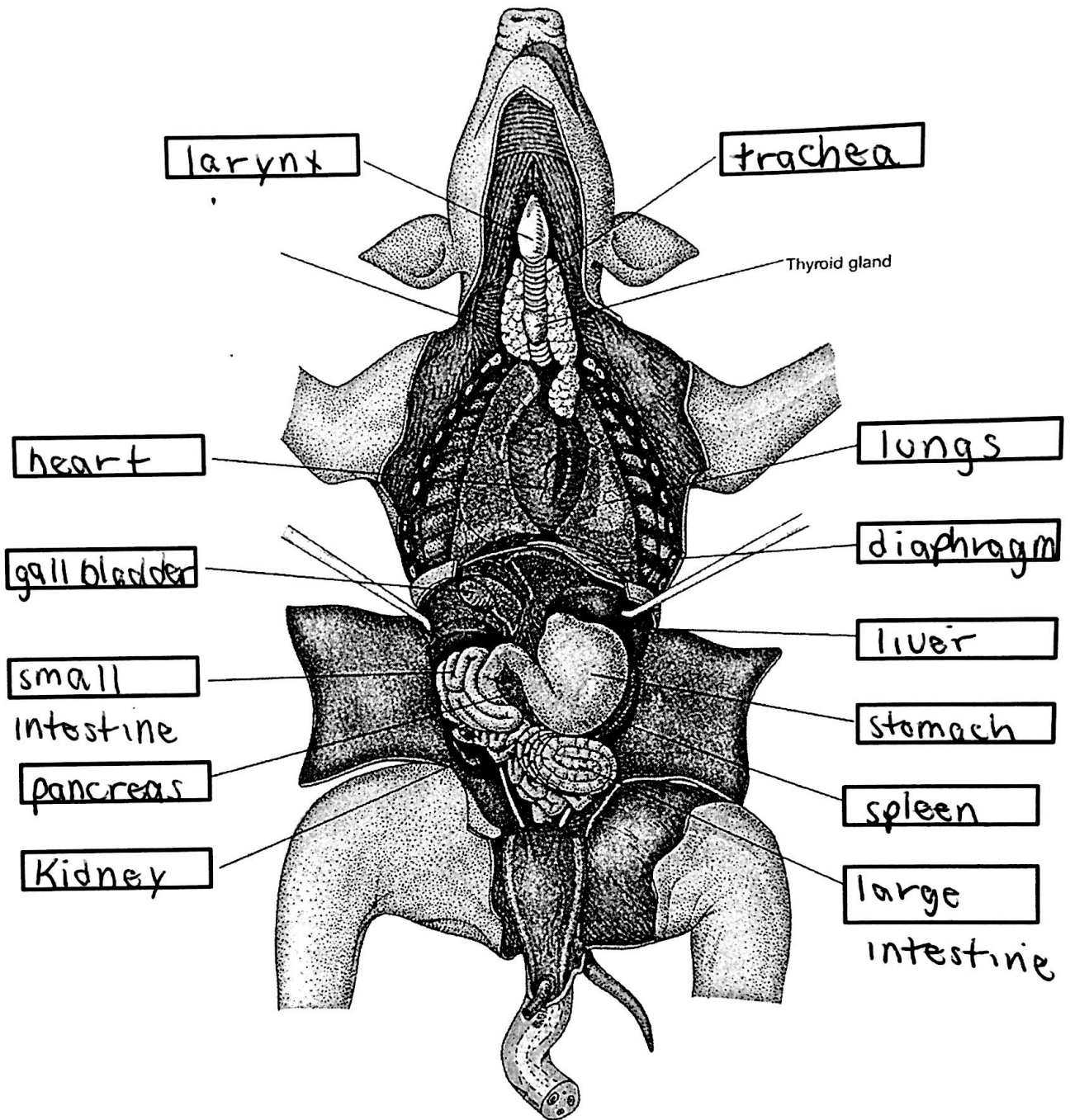
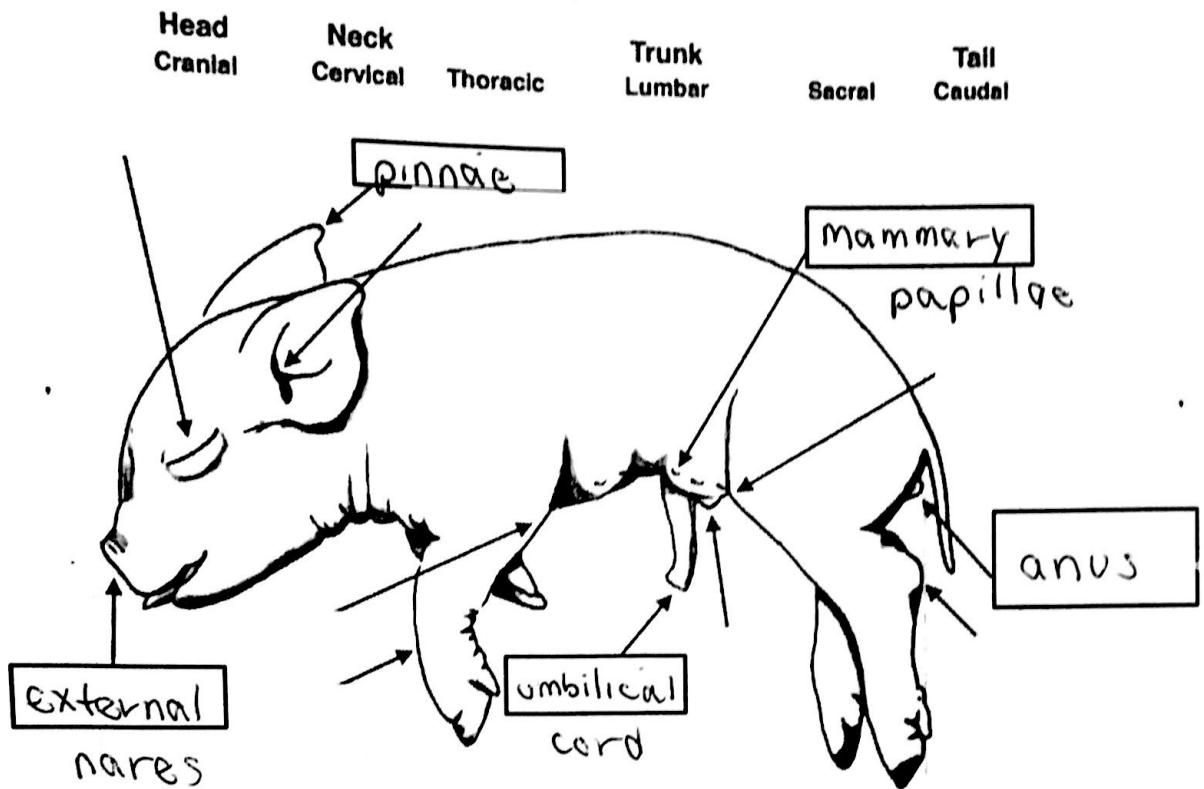
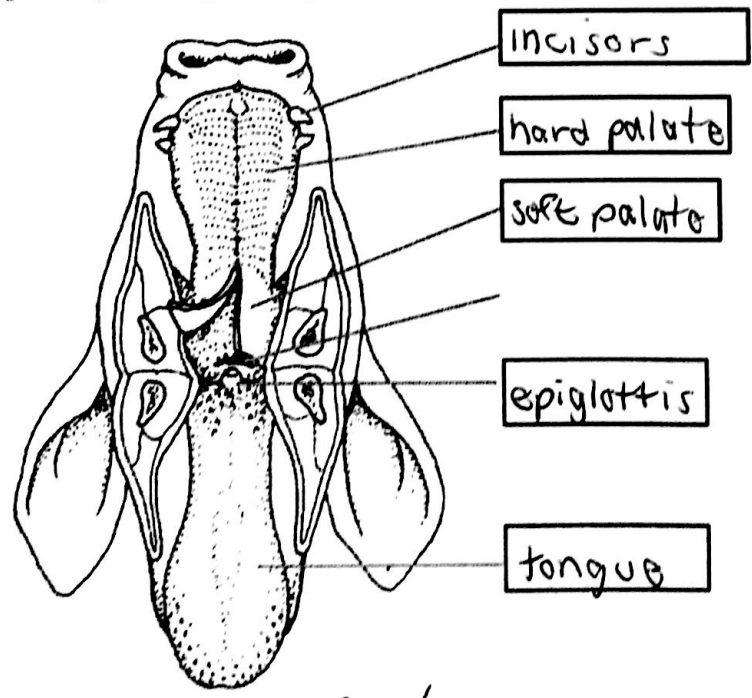


Figure 1 - External anatomy (lateral view)
